City News

Community Shred Event – The County of Los Angeles Sheriff’s Identity Theft Task Force and the City of Agoura Hills will be hosting a “Community Shred” event On Saturday, October 9, 2010. The event will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude at 3:00 p.m. It will be held in the Agoura Hills City Hall parking lot, 30001 Ladyface Court.

This event is FREE and open to the public. Participants will be able to drive up to the event and have their personal documents unloaded by “Shred-It” personnel (Sheriff’s contractor) and shredded on site. Please see the attached flyers for more information.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Lost Hills / Malibu Station has receptacles for the safe disposal of unused or expired pharmaceuticals, including prescription drugs, controlled substances and “sharps” (needles, syringes). Located at 27050 Agoura Road, between Lost Hills Road and Liberty Canyon, the unwanted items may be deposited in the “Safe Drug Surrender” bins near the entrance of the station under an anonymous “no questions asked” policy. The new program allows area residents to safely dispose of the items in a secure and environmentally protective manner. Customers are urged to not flush or pour unused medicines down the drain. They are harmful to the environment and wastewater treatment systems are not able to remove many substances. Remember the slogan, “No Drugs Down the Drain!” – take them to Lost Hills instead.
