The Committee met on May 2nd to review issues that are facing our members and business community. As customary, our public representatives initiated our discussion with various topics affecting their jurisdictions and stakeholders:

1. Cynthia Scott, representative from Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky Office, reviewed some key items:
 - a. The Boundary Review Committee is seeking input from all stakeholders until month end. A key objective is that each of the supervisorial districts have about the same number residents. Assuming the current boundaries, the Supervisor's District already has about the right number.

- b. The Topanga Fire Drill is scheduled for May 7th.
- c. The County CEO's Office has prepared a draft budget that assumes no additional tax increases. While the \$23.3M budget still has a \$220M shortfall, it involves no layoffs and preserves critical services.
2. Rebekah Rodriguez-Lynn, representative from Senator Fran Pavely's Office, commented on the following issues:
 - a. The California State Budget has a \$25.4B shortfall and the Senate has not reached a consensus on how to resolve it.
 - b. The Democrats have already agreed on \$11.2B in cuts that were signed into law last month.
 - c. The Governor favors extending existing taxes rather than taking additional cuts.
 - d. The original plan to place a measure on a June ballot that would allow Californians to vote on whether to maintain existing taxes failed to get the necessary votes in the Senate. Both main parties are contemplating next steps to resolve the crisis.
3. Jeff Reinhardt, representative from the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District, discussed several timely items:
 - a. Ample water supplies are foreseen for this year. Most reservoirs in the State are filled to capacity.
 - b. The Board eliminated the water budgeting program and is refunding the excess usage charges paid by ratepayers under the program.
 - c. A rate increase is anticipated later in the year to cover higher operations costs.

Cynthia Scott, Field Representative from Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky's Office, requested that the Calabasas Chamber of Commerce participate in the County Redistricting process. She gave the group the community meeting dates and the following email to write comments to by 5-31 at commserv@bos.lacounty.gov. The Supervisor would like to see the Third District's boundaries largely preserved as is. The area is a cohesive district geographically connected by communities of interest in the San Fernando Valley, Las Virgenes Region, and greater Westside. The primary considerations for maintaining the existing boundaries are 1) common interests of

local communities in preserving the Santa Monica Mountains and other key natural resources, 2) effective inter-community relationships that are already in place and working, 3) the economic impact of millions of visitors that use the beaches and Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area parks and trails has on the communities, and 4) common transportation and infrastructure needs of the District.

A motion proposed by Michelle Dornfest, EGAC Committee Member, to support Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky's plan for redistricting was passed by the committee. In particular, Dornfest noted that the communities within Zev's District have strongly supported his long term work in preserving the Santa Monica Mountains Open Space and Wildlife Corridors.

Tips for on-line marketing success from Kay Wallace, Founder of Tools 2 Connect.

Create a Successful Event Using Social Media

Creating an event on Facebook and LinkedIn can help you grow your network of attendees. Once the details are created, publish it to your fans or connections and ask them to share the event with their connections. This will help you invite people that are not in your direct network, resulting in better attendance.

Let's look at this event from both sides. If you plan on attending an event, be sure to share the event with your own connections and ask them to do the same. I like to call it the Clairol effect: "you tell two friends and they tell two friends and so on and so on." Using the Calabasas Wine Tasting as an example: if each member shared this event from Facebook to his or her connection, how many more people could we get to attend? If attendance goes up at events then chamber membership goes up and the result is more business for you and the community.
